

Finnish Public Libraries Act 2016

- In effect from 1st of January 2017
 - regulations about public libraries since 1928
 - the present act is fifth in order
- The objectives of this Act are to promote:
- 1) equal opportunities for everyone to access education and culture;
- 2) availability and use of information;
- 3) reading culture and versatile literacy skills;
- 4) opportunities for lifelong learning and competence development;
- 5) active citizenship, **democracy** and freedom of expression.


- Helsinki City Libraries (all 37 of them):

- Library chat: "How can I renew my loans?"

Questionnaire & interviews

- Questionnaire conducted in early 2022 by Kulmia Insight, ordered by Helsinki City Library. Questionnaire was followed with interviews for target groups in late 2022.
- Five target groups for interviews:
 - Regular users of library computers
 - Library non-users
 - Language café participants
 - Members of a book circle
 - School classes
- Questionnare and interviews were about library information services
 both in library space and library online services.

In what different ways do you search for information? (Top 3 and library)



What is your most common way of searching information? (Top 3 and library)





"It came to me as a total surprise that I could search information from the library. I must be too much of a digital native to be bothered to go to library and ask something."

Library was mainly thought as a place for books, and the possibility to get information services wasn't well known at all.





Library is seen as reliable (90%) and neutral (87%) source of information. However library information services don't seem to be **easy and fast enough to access**.

- Even the 3D-printers and possibility to borrow tools were **more familiar** than information services.
- 58 % would **not** turn to library in search of information on news and **current affairs**.
- 11 % would not go to library or library web page to find out about new books!

Case: The book circle

- This group appreciated the library, but surprisingly didn't use its services that much. Loved personalized service in theory, but in reality used the self-service automats for checking out and returning their loans.
- Book tips and recommendations were asked mainly from friends and searched online, **not from the library.**
- They thought that library information services are reliable, but would benefit **someone else**, not them.

What the h*ll should we do about it?



Educating ourselves first

- It's a confusing world. Training ourselves for information evaluation and search in online world ruled by algorithms and twisted by fake news.
- Helsinki City Library started training on spring 2023 together with The Finnish Lifelong Learning Association for skills in digital information litteracy.
 - Controlling digital identity
 - Recognizing the effect of algorithms and AI on information searches
 - Participating in decision making on digital platforms

Re-thinking our information services

- Organizing targeted information services, for example fact checking workshops before elections etc.
- Digital help offered by library is well recognized, needed and used – should we concentrate more on that?
- **Broadening** the view: events and exhibitions* are very valuable information services.



A REVOLUTION OF VALUES

Black Washingtonians have always faced the threat of displacement. Reverend Walter Fauntroy, pastor of New Bethel Baptist Church, vowed that this wouldn't happen in Shaw, the neighborhood surrounding his church. Many there had been pushed out of Southwest and were living in overcrowded, aging apartments.

Longstanding Black communities in Georgetown, Foggy Bottom, and Tenleytown had been pushed out decades actives in addition, "skun clearance" had targeted poor people living in alley housing throughout the city. D.C.'s mapricity Black Southwast inhightorhood was demolished for new housing and freeways in the regios, tearing the community apart. Some LGOD businesses and 23,000 residents were forced to leave.


Fauntroy secured federal funds to form the Model Inner-Citly Community Organization (MICCO), which help local control of redevelopment and hired neighborhood residents. MICCO helped homeowners make repairs and built new, affordable housing our residents who rented from slumlords. In March 1967, Dr. King came to D.C. to support MICCO's plan for community-led renewal.
